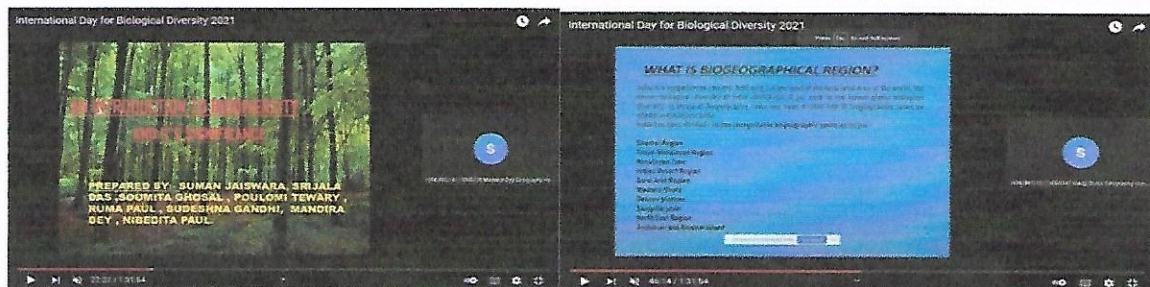
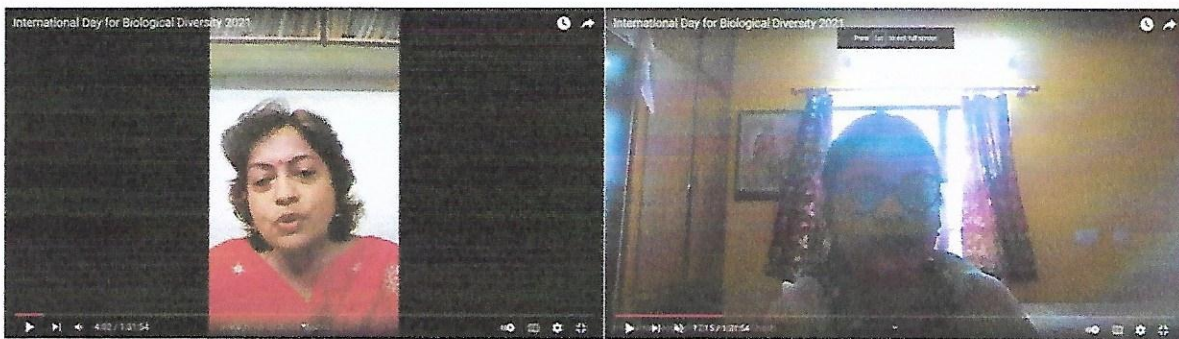
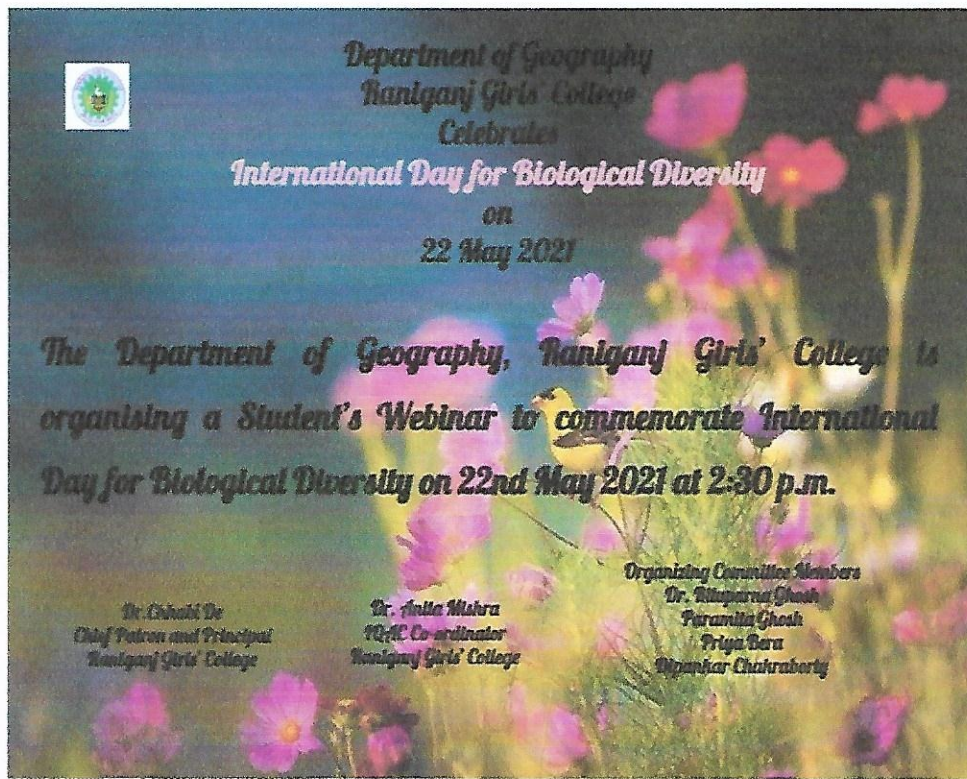


Students' Webinar to commemorate "International Day for Biological Diversity" organized by the Department of Geography on 22.05.2021
